The Ubele Initiative (<u>www.ubele.org</u>) seeks expressions of interest for a 12 month full time paid internship opportunity.

We are seeking an exceptional young adult (ideally under 30 years of age), who is interested in working with us to create a new intergenerational leadership development programme for the African Diaspora community.

We require someone with:

- At least one year's experience of working with the African Diaspora in the UK
- Excellent writing skills
- Strong communication skills including ability to use social media
- Partnership development and networking skills
- A keen interest in supporting young emerging leaders
- The ability to solicit the views of young adults (21-30 years) and use them in programme design
- Project development and implementation skills
- Experience in community development
- Creativity and ability to innovate
- Flexibility and a willingness to work at least one evening per week and occasional weekends
- Willingness to work from a flexible base in Tottenham, North London

The Ubele Initiative is in the process of negotiating London Living Wage level of funding to support this full time, one year internship opportunity.
